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Chester Zoo Follow Up

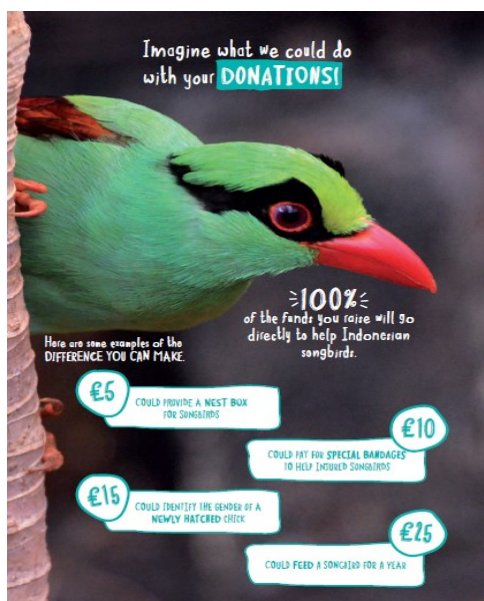
Linked to our topic, we have been learning about several songbirds, which are critically endangered.



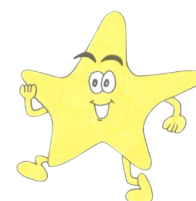
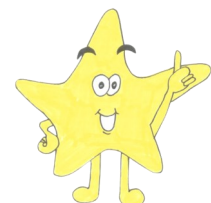
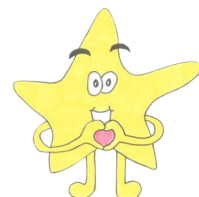
Our Sound Achievement Team want to fundraise as much money as possible so that we can donate money to Chester Zoo in their project to conserve the species.
