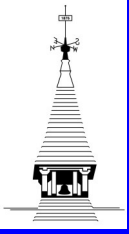

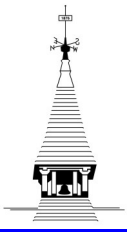
Parents Afternoon/Evening
