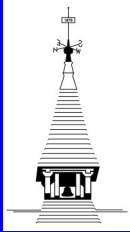

#### Our Residential Trip Programme

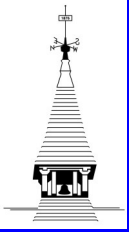
