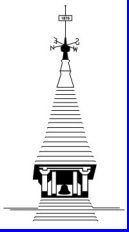

Time to pick up children:- 6pm

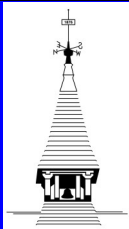


Year 3-6

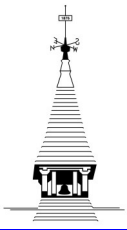

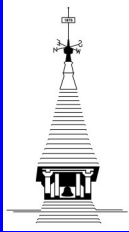

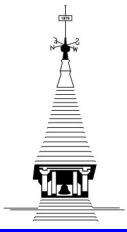
In aid of the Salvation Army Christmas Toy Appeal
