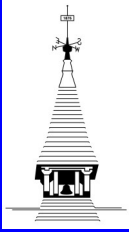

CHRISTMAS FAIR

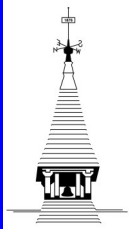
All children will be opening the Christmas Fair next

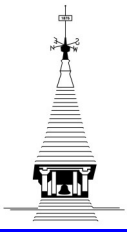

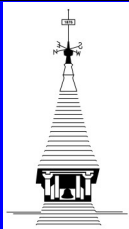
