#### KEY NOTES ABOUT SCHOOL

School starts 8.30am (children need to be lined up on the yellow line ready). If your child is at Breakfast club, they will be supervised so they can join the line at 8.30am.

You are welcome to use the school drop off from 8.20am at the car park.

School finishes at 3.00pm.

Mrs Ashley runs our before school and after school wraparound care at Outdoor Fun.

## COLLECTING CHILDREN

- Please let us know if someone different from usual is collecting your child. You can either ring the school office or speak to the member of staff in the morning to pass on the message.
- Please also let us know if someone on a regular basis will be collecting your child (e.g. Grandparents on a Tuesday).
- If someone comes to collect your child and we do not know who they are, we will not be able to send your child with them until this has been checked with you.



# WHAT IS THE EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE?

## THE EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE (EYFS) AREAS OF LEARNING

The Foundation Stage Curriculum (revised 2012)

#### There are 3 Prime Areas

- I. Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- 2. Communication and Language
- 3. Physical Development

#### Then there are 4 Specific Areas

- 4. Literacy;
- 5. Mathematics;
- 6. Understanding the World;
- 7. Expressive Arts and Design

#### NATIONAL EXPECTATIONS

- By the end of the Reception year the goal is for your child to be able to:
  - · Read simple sentences without help
  - · Write in sentences without help
  - · Order, recognise and write numbers 0-20
  - · Add and subtract with simple numbers equally
  - · Double and halve and share amounts

Regular attendance is crucial in order to help support children achieve this.

#### **BASELINE ASSESSMENT**

- Throughout the year in Reception, we assess the children against the ELGs and earlier developmental age bands. This is usually through observation of the children during their chosen activities. We measure their progress and set specific targets to help children to develop skills.
- To begin the year we make an initial assessment indicating children's starting points.

#### THE EYFS PROFILE

- At the end of the school year you will receive an EYFS profile for your child, detailing whether they have met the goals for each area of learning.
- You will be told whether your child's development is emerging, expected or exceeding in relation to the goals.
- Your feedback and contributions from home on where your child is achieving on the Profile is really important to us to help us to inform our assessments (Class Dojo).



#### **CLASSROOM ROUTINES**

#### Each day there will be a mixture of:

- Exploration and Play
- Whole Class Learning (number rhymes and songs, counting, games, listening to stories, learning and talking about number facts, watching shared writing)
- Guided Group Work (working with other children and a teacher)
- Independent Group Work (working with other children alone)

#### MATHEMATICS - NUMBER

By the end of the year the children have to be confident with numbers to 20.

This does not mean just being able to count to 20, but understanding number thoroughly, e.g. that the number 8 is the same as double 4, or 5 + 3, or 2 + 6, or 1 + 7 etc.

The children will learn how to add, subtract, divide ("share"), halve and double over the year.




#### POSITIVE DISCIPLINE



- Head Teacher Awards












#### HOME/SCHOOL LINKS

#### Writing in the planner

We will provide a Reading Record for you to record reading at home and like to use these books as another method for ensuring a strong homeschool link.

#### **BOOK BAGS AND PE KITS**

• Please make sure children bring their book bags into school each day (except for trip days). You may personalise the book bag with one key ring so children can easily identify their bag.

• Children will need to come into school dressed in their PE kits on Mondays and Thursdays, as these will be our P.E. days.

#### CLASS WEBSITE AND DOJO

• Please check our Class Dojo regularly to see learning in Diamond Class. This is where I will also write regular updates.





### FRUIT AND WATER

Children in Reception and Key Stage One (Years one and two) are provided with a piece of fruit each day.

Each child will also need to have an individual water bottle to access water throughout the day.

Please remove children's jewellery before coming to school on these days.


## YEAR 6 BUDDY

We will pair your child with a Year 6 buddy as another form of pastoral care. It is a wonderful system and the Year 6 children assist during play and lunch times as well as through some learning times (e.g. listening to the Reception children read).

- All communications should first and foremost go through to the class teacher, unless it is something which is needed to be directed to the Deputy, Headteacher.
- We will be keeping you regularly updated through the website, Facebook, Class Dojo and newsletter about what your child is doing in class.
- Reminders, or other general information will go through our teachers2parentsapp and Class Dojo. We will be keeping both running as we trial its use for the whole school. Microsoft Teams will be used for Virtual Parent Meetings.








#### PTA
